FOCUS

This webinar will cover Component 3 on A-level PE, and give teachers practical teaching approaches on several of the different topic areas, focusing on how to cover all OCR assessment criteria, common student pitfalls, and engaging teaching strategies to ensure it is not the 'last priority' component for students! The session will also give a brief overview of exam technique, the 10marker essay and common errors from an 'examiners' perspective.
